HORSEMANSHIP AWARD

The Idaho Horsemanship Award is a test of skills and knowledge in horsemanship. The purpose of the award is to honor the most talented youth riders in Idaho.

Any youth 14 years of age by January 1, 2022 and not more than 19 years of age who is enrolled in an organized horse program may apply for this award.

Horse Project members interested in competing for this award need to contact the Extension Office to register by June 1, 2022.
